HALF-PRICE SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR at St Crispin's School: Wednesday 5th – Friday 7th December 2012

Dear Parents and Students

The Library has organised a **Scholastic Book Fair** in St Crispin's School Library, which will be in school for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of the 1st week in **December (5/12 - 7/12/12)** – just in time for Christmas! **This year ALL books will be sold at the recession-busting bargain price of 50% of their normal cover price!**



The Scholastic Book Company is sending several bookcases worth of GREAT BOOKS all of interest to pre-teens and teenagers (along with various small fun items: funky pens, pencils, bookmarks etc.). **All the books will be on display at the Book Fair just outside the school library at break, lunchtimes and after school (3.10 – 4.10pm) each day during the fair.**

Students can look round and make purchases at the fair at any of these times, if parents wish to look round and make purchases, they will need to come in **after school**.

Buying Book Fair books: Parents can send in cash with students, or can come in to the after-school session to pay by debit/credit card in person, OR - **new this year** - Parents can also buy a discounted **Book Fair voucher online** in advance (a £10 voucher costs £9, £20 cost £17 ...) for their children to spend at our Book Fair. Just visit <http://bookfairs.scholastic.co.uk/parents> and select the voucher amount you want to buy. You will also need to enter the school name during the process to allocate the voucher to be spent at our school's book fair. Print off the voucher, which will be emailed to you - your child can then use it to purchase books at the fair.
