Dear Parents/Guardians,

St Crispin's school is launching an exciting leadership programme for all Year 9 and 10 students that will start in January 2013. The leadership programme is inspired by the London 2012 Olympic Games and is based on the Olympic rings and values. As a direct result of this programme, St Crispin's school became a registered Get Set network school which allows us to make use of the Olympic education logo on our website.

Year 9 and 10 students are invited to participate by applying to form part of a student leadership team that will be linked to a specific department in the school. Students will be given opportunities to develop leadership skills by participating in activities created for this specific purpose. These activities could include organising and running challenge events for younger students, mentoring, developing resources, running clubs, running online forums etc. The activities will depend on the department the student forms part of. All students are given the opportunity to choose which department they would like to be a part of.

The programme will run for the duration of Year 9 and 10. Participating students will be expected to stay dedicated to one department for one year but will be given the chance to change to another department for the second year if they so wish. Each year they will work towards achieving two Olympic 'rings'. Each ring represents a specific value. They are as follows:

Blue – Commitment

Red – Achievement

Black – Mentoring

Yellow – Volunteering/Community

Green – Public Performance

Year 9 students will work towards the green and yellow rings and year 10 students will work towards the red and black ring. If all four rings are achieved, the blue ring will be awarded at the start of Year 11.

This is a fantastic opportunity for our students to get involved in Leadership at St Crispin's school while developing their own skills and character. I look forward to working with as many students as possible on this exciting programme.
