Year 10 Enterprise – 2012/2013

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of some exciting opportunities, associated with Work Related Learning, that are happening for Year 10 at St Crispin's School.

As part of National Curriculum changes, the area of Enterprise is to be delivered to Key Stage 4 pupils. It will be linked to Careers and Work Experience and come under the umbrella of Work Related Learning.



It will initially be delivered through two days this academic year that have been set aside as "Enterprise Days", the first one being on Thursday 11th October 2012. The other is Wednesday 26th June 2013. Enterprise will also be reinforced throughout the year in GCSE curriculum areas.

On Enterprise Days, due to KS3 pupils being out of school on trips, Enterprise activities will replace normal KS4 lessons.

Points to Note:

- Year 10 pupils must still wear school uniform.
- The day starts at 8.30am and finishes at 3.10pm.
- Pupils only need to bring pens, pencils, rulers etc. into school on Enterprise Days.
- There is no charge for these activities.

We are being helped in this venture by the Central Berkshire Education and Business Partnership (EBP), the same company that will help us with Work Experience later next year.

The EBP will be taking photographs during the activities for display in our school and some literature that they produce for other schools, businesses and the local press.
