Theme Week – 3rd – 7th June 2013

As a part of our commitment to developing the pupil's learning skills, we will be running a cross curricular Theme Week for Year 8 from Monday 3rd to Friday 7th June. The students will be off timetable, and instead of attending their regular lessons, they will be producing work based around the theme of Cultural Diversity. This will complement the school's on-going PSHCE work, giving the pupils a chance to creatively explore such challenging issues as what it means to be British, cultural, social and even technological divisions in society, and the things we take for granted today that have come from cultures around the world.
