Theme Week – 3rd – 7th June 2013

As a part of our commitment to developing the pupils' learning skills, we will be running a cross curricular Theme Week for Year 9 from Monday 3rd to Friday 7th June. The students will be off timetable, and instead of attending their regular lessons, they will be producing work based around the theme of **Sustainable Lifestyles**. This will complement the work we already do on Global Issues and Healthy Lifestyles. During the week, pupils will have the opportunity to investigate the environmental impact of modern life, the ways in which they can make a difference as individuals, and examine the roles technology and business have to play in creating a sustainable future. There will also be the opportunity for pupils to go on a visit to a local farm.
