

Parents and Pupils Committee Terms of Reference

- 1. Ensure that all relevant information is communicated to parents as dictated under current legislation.
- 2. Review and challenge the processes used to communicate student progress to parents and pupils.
- 3. Review, challenge and recommend all relevant policies for approval: Anti Bullying, Attendance, Behaviour, Complaints, Drugs Education, Drugs Related Incidents, Parental Consultation, Safeguarding (incl. Child Protection), School Activities Charging and Remission, Sex and Relationships Education, Support for pupils with medical condition.
- 4. Review all school trips and approve residential and overseas visits.
- 5. Review and challenge the Home School Agreement every two years, or when the school proposes any change.
- 6. Have an overview of school meals provision and food available for sale on the school premises.
- 7. Ensure there are effective channels of communication to allow parents and pupils to voice their opinions and express their levels of satisfaction.
