## Final details for the forthcoming trip to Disneyland Paris

Before Departure:

- Students must obtain an European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) and hand to travel group leader
- Students must have a passport which they should bring with them on the departure day. If you hold a non-EU passport you must check with the relevant embassy that it is valid for the trip to France. It must have 6 months validity.
- Students have changed their money into Euros. Students will have breakfast provided but will need money for all other meals.
- It is likely to be cold – so please bring warm clothing.

On the Day (10<sup>th</sup> Feb)

- Students must be at the school no later than 6.15 am with their passport.
- We will be travelling via Eurotunnel at Approx 10.20am
- They should bring with them a packed lunch for the journey
- We are expected to arrive in resort mid afternoon
- Attend Wild West Show

On return (13<sup>th</sup>)

- We expect to return to the school at approximately 7pm
- We will ask students to contact parents when they arrive at Dover.

When at Disney the students will not leave the confines of the resort. Students will have time in the park on their own and will attend seminars in the Disney village.

All students will be given a handbook with information on the visit. It contains all the information that they need with regard to the trip. Most importantly it covers the trip rules laid down by the travel company and supported by the school. I would be grateful if you could read these and discuss them with your child.
