

Gifted and Talented in Maths



KS3

At key stage 3, pupils are encouraged to investigate and question the world of maths through exciting, rich lessons and extra-curricular activities. Gifted and Talented mathematicians are stretched in lessons by following an accelerated course in set 1 and offered a range of exciting clubs and activities throughout the year.

Maths club runs every Friday lunchtime in the maths block. Pupils in years 7 and 8 are invited to join us to investigate problems, solve puzzles and play maths games and chess.

In all key stages our best pupils take part in the annual UKMT Maths challenges in school, with a majority of pupils gaining bronze, silver and gold awards. Pupils who do well in the Maths Challenges will be invited through to Kangaroo and Olympiad rounds. In recent years we have had pupils invited to take part in National Team competitions as a result of their Maths Challenge performances.

KS4

At GCSE pupils are stretched by an interesting and varied syllabus that focuses on applying methods to functional and real life challenges.

Pupils are encouraged to attend revision sessions targeted at 8 and 9 grade work to ensure they are fully supported in the more demanding aspects of the course.

KS5

A-Level Maths is one of the most popular A-Levels at St Crispin's as pupils enjoy the challenge and content of the course. As well as offering A-Level maths we also have A-Level further maths for our exceptional pupils who are looking to take maths at university. Both courses are very popular and results are high.
