Wilderness Expertise Kenya 2018

Uk1 Weekend – Saturday 21st- Sunday 22nd October

As I am sure you are all well aware, we are now starting the official processes involved in preparing your son/daughter for Kenya at the end of the academic year.

As such, we have an important weekend coming up, where pupils will spend the time in school, getting to know their team, discussing progress in terms of fundraising, and starting to devise their itinerary for when they are in Kenya.

This is known as the **UK1 Training Programme**, and hopefully you and/or your son/daughter, have received **UK1 Info Pack** letter, or an e-mail, directly from Wilderness giving details on this event. However, I wanted to just send this letter to confirm some details and will also attach the aforementioned letter in case it has not yet been received.

The weekend will take place over the **21st – 22nd October**, and pupils will stay overnight in the school on the Saturday night. They will be sleeping in the two drama studios – one per team – and should have access to the PE department showers for the morning.

Pupils should also be reminded that there will be a range of activities they will be taking part in, and as such should bring appropriate clothes (suggestions can be found in the attached Wilderness Pack), especially as the weather could well be quite cold.

Budget for food will be provided by Wilderness, shopping with a budget, whilst catering for everyone's needs, is a major part of the expedition and students will have their first chance to practice this as a team over the weekend.

Please ensure any specific medication, including inhalers, are given to the pupil and clearly marked with their name so that it can be accessed if needed.

Lastly, you will be responsible for transport to and from the weekend. They need to be there for 9.50am for a prompt 10.00am start on the Saturday, and will be finished at 4.00pm on the Sunday, so can you please ensure they know their arrangements for drop-off and pick up.
