

On Tuesday, 26th January students attended the **'Transformations in Literature'** ceremony to receive their certificates and prizes.



The course was delivered by Amy Smith, an ex-pupil of St Crispins and graduate of Warwick University who created the 12 week 'seminar' style course to help prepare students for Further Education. Running from January to May last year, the course focussed on the 'Role of the Undead in Literature' including study of works by Edgar Allen Poe and Mary Shelley. The students from Years 9-13 had to apply for the course and attend an hour and a half seminar once a fortnight. During the project they had to keep a 'workbook' showing their research and development of ideas culminating in a 1,500 word essay based on a question of their devising.

Receiving prizes were Holly Kelsey for most outstanding over-all project, Emma Osborn for her outstanding workbook and Abi Rose for an outstanding essay.
