Learning Bursary

I am writing to inform you about a new scheme for students in Years 10 and 11 who are in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG). As I have explained to your son/daughter at an assembly this week, each eligible student is entitled to a **Learning Bursary** of £100. This money is for them to purchase things they need for their studies. I have explained to them that I will hold this fund for them, and how to request items to be purchased. I have also given them some examples of things they may wish to buy, which is listed below:

- Calculator
- Text books
- Revision guides
- Revision cards
- Stationery
