

More Able in Geography



KS3

Students are invited to termly sessions after school, in which they are challenged to develop enquiry skills, investigating some of the big geographical questions of our times. The sessions are designed to advance students' independent research skills and use of GIS, whilst encouraging them to develop personal opinions about current global issues.

KS4

Students are invited to attend sessions which focus on developing explanation and analysis skills, which not only support students in their GCSE's, but also begin preparing them for A-Level Geography. Students are encouraged to participate in the KS4 fieldtrip which provides the opportunity to advance their enquiry skills.



KS5

Students are encouraged to engage with further reading available from the geography library, which supports their studies at A2. Monthly editions of topical magazines are also available to support students in broadening their understanding of current global issues. Students are invited to go on a Field Trip to Sierra De Gredos in Spain, where they get the opportunity to practise fieldwork skills and complete a range of geographical investigations.
