



16 – 19 Tuition Fund (Covid 19 additional funding)

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Key Priority: To support students in receipt of the 16 – 19 Tuition Fund to achieve Grade 4 in English and Maths GCSE and to support them in their Level 3 qualifications to allow them to make good progress:

- Continuation of tuition for English and Maths GCSE
- Targeted study support for individual students
- Practical support to access all aspects of their programme of study

The allocation to St. Crispin's is £2,326. This funding is used for small group tuition for English and Maths GCSE for students who did not achieve a Grade 4 in Y11. This tuition is led by teachers in the English and Maths departments who have significant expertise and experience in supporting students to achieve this grade.

Further to this, identified individual students are receiving one to one study support with a teacher and/or LSA to support their chosen Level 3 qualifications. This is in addition to the support work that the 6th form pastoral team already does. (During periods of remote learning, the study support and pastoral meetings take place via Teams.)

Further to this, this funding is also being used to provide practical assistance to students by purchasing for them computer software, hardware, text books and other learning materials.
